

COVID Requirements/Procedures

The following guidelines are in effect until further notice or until further updated by PPSI due to the changing guidelines from the facility and local health departments for all PPSI in-person programming. Thank you for your understanding and your cooperation. We appreciate your help in carefully reading and following the procedures.

Ensuring the health and safety of the PPSI community and beyond is our first priority and only works when we all do our part, together.

In order to take part in an in-person PPSI program, families, teachers and faculty who will be on campus are required to read and commit to following these requirements/procedures. There will be a place on the Registration Form to click that you have read, agree and accept the terms and conditions presented in this Covid Requirement/Procedure document as part of the Participant Waiver. Hardcopies of the Participant Waiver will also be signed in person at registration.

My family and I understand and accept that there are risks inherent in being physically present on a campus community during a global pandemic, but by taking care of others and myself, we can contribute to public health and safety. To do so, my family and I will follow these guidelines:

Requirements/Procedures for in-person instruction at Peaks to Plains Suzuki Institute

1. **Vaccination:** Everyone's personal choice to be vaccinated or not will be respected.
2. **Precautions:** Masks at all in-person events will be **required for everyone** in attendance regardless of whether or not they have been vaccinated until further notice or as updated by the facility and health guidelines. The only exception to this is for children that are below the age of 2 - children below the age of 2 may be unmasked. Everyone ages 2 and older must be masked— no neck gaiters or bandanas or the like will be allowed. Please plan to attend PPSI in a properly fitted high quality mask that covers both your nose and mouth, preferably a cloth mask with a 5 layer filter or a Kn95 mask. You will be sent home and forfeit with no refunds if this is not adhered to.
3. **Prohibitions on Attendance.** Attendee(s) acknowledge and agree that no person may enter the facility or attend PPSI if that person is positive for Covid or has symptoms including but not limited to a cough, fever, congested, sore throat, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, flu-like symptoms, gastrointestinal upset, or experienced a recent loss of taste or smell.
4. **Illness:** Anyone in your family (students, parents, siblings, etc.) presenting ANY symptoms of illness (this includes all Covid symptoms as well as symptoms of ANY other illness- examples but not limited to fever, cough, runny/stuffy nose, sore throat, headache, stomach ache, diarrhea etc.) will be asked to leave PPSI immediately and will forfeit with no makeups or refunds. 5. **Exposure Covid-19:** If you or a family member in your household have recently been in contact with someone who was diagnosed with Covid or currently has Covid or has Covid symptoms or has recently traveled outside of the US, you must report this to the Director. If you or a family member are quarantined from a possible exposure, you must report that to the Director. If you or a family member are currently awaiting COVID test results, you must report that to the Director as well as the results of the test. If you experience symptoms within 10 days following PPSI, you will obtain a Covid PCR test and notify the Director of the test result.
6. **Assumption of Risk** Regardless of adherence to recommendations and following procedures, there is a risk of COVID exposure whenever an individual enters into a public space, house or building with other people. By attending PPSI at Stargate School, 14530 Washington St, Thornton, CO 80023, the Attendee(s) acknowledges and agrees that the Attendee(s) is/are assuming the risk of COVID exposures.
7. The Attendee(s) understand that the contents of this document will remain in effect until further notice and that the Attendee(s) AND their family will follow the requirements/procedures in this document.
8. Failure to follow any part of this document will result in an executive decision on Attendee(s) continued attendance at PPSI and forfeiture of tuition and fees.
